



# LAKE GRANBY YACHT CLUB

## 2020 Notice of Races

### 1 EVENTS

The Lake Granby Yacht Club (LGYC) will conduct a Spring and Summer Series, a Commodore's Race, and a Manifest Race in 2020 as the Organizing Authority. These Series and Races will be held on Lake Granby, Granby, CO. The Commodore's race is a "fun race" for the sailors and their families and will not be scored.

### 2 RULES

The LGYC Series Races and Manifest Race will be governed by rules as defined by the *2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, except as changed by each Series Sailing Instructions (SIs), this NOR, the Boating Regulations of Colorado Parks & Wildlife and of the Arapahoe National Recreation Area. Series SIs will be available five (5) days prior to the first race of each series on the LGYC website [www.lakegranbyyachtclub.com](http://www.lakegranbyyachtclub.com). It is each racers responsibility to review the SI's prior to the day of the race.

The starting sequence as described in Rule 26 of the **2017-2020 US Racing Rule Sailing** will be modified to include an "Alert to Sailors" consisting of 3 short blasts one minute prior to the Warning. See Addendum A attached to this NOR.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 All boats wanting to race for that day's races must check in at the Skippers Meeting prior to the first race of the day. Membership in the LGYC is required. All boats must be helmed primarily by a LGYC Member in good standing for the 2020 Season. **All Races sailed prior to complete payment of their 2020 membership dues, will be scored DNC.**
- 3.2 The Spring and Summer Series and Manifest Race is open to all PHRF rated boats. A boat's PHRF will be determined based on the PHRF Fleet Handbook. In the event a boat is not listed in the handbook, the rating will be determined by the Race Chairman. All races will be scored based on the PHRF handicap system.

- 4 **FEES** The normal entry fee for the Spring and Summer series and the Manifest Race is \$10.00 per day. Because of COVID-19 we are changing the method of collection the fees. Fees for the individual racers for each race will be accumulated throughout the racing season and collected after the Manifest Race. An invoice will be EMAILED to each racer after the completion of the Manifest Race. Remittance can be made by mail to the club treasurer (currently Terry Pratt). Please let us know if you want the invoice send through regular mail. Directions for payment will be included in the invoice. There is no entry fee for the Commodore's race.

### 5 SCHEDULES

- 5.1 **Spring Series:** Six (6) races on Three (3) Saturdays - June 13 (Races 1 & 2), June 27 (Races 3 & 4), July 11 (Races 5 & 6), 2020. First Alert to Racers signal at 12:30 hours. Two (2) races are scheduled for each day series.

**5.2 Summer Series:** Six (6) races on Three (3) Saturdays – August 1 (Races 1 & 2), August 15 (Races 3 & 4), August 29 (Races 5 & 6), 2020. First Alert to Racers signal at 12:30 hours. Two (2) races are scheduled for each day series.

**5.3 Manifest Race:** September 12, 2020. First Alert to Racers signal at 12:30 hours.

Note: The Commodore's race is scheduled for July 25, 2020 and will be a "just for fun" race and will not be scored.

**6 APPENDIX T** Appendix T of the RRS shall be in effect for all races of this Series.

## **7 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

**7.1** The SI's will be posted on the Lake Granby Yacht Club's website ([www.lakegranbyyachtclub.com](http://www.lakegranbyyachtclub.com)) at least one day prior to each race day.

**7.2** Weather permitting, the Starting Sequence for the first race of that day of each series is scheduled to start at **12:30PM**. (See Addendum A Starting sequence).

## **8 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Each Series Sailing Instructions (SIs) may modify the rules. Changes to the SI's will be allowed at the Skipper's Meeting and on the water under a Code 'L' flag. Anticipated changes include but are not limited to modifications of Appendix A as described in **13-Scoring**,

## **9 SKIPPER'S MEETING**

A skipper's meeting will be held prior to each race to go over any changes to the SI's, current weather conditions and any other racing announcements. The Skipper's Meeting will be held at 11:00am on E-Dock. In order to aid in social distancing, please limit participants to only one person representing each boat being raced. Attendance is NOT required.

Due to the COVID-19 Corona Virus, all attendees will be required to follow the current state guidelines. Participants should:

1. Strictly not attend the meeting if you are unwell, have a fever, cough or respiratory symptoms.
2. Stay at least 6 feet away from others ("social distancing").
3. Wear a mask
4. Undertake regular preventive measures such as cough etiquette, frequent washing of hands, use of hand sanitizer, etc.

## **10 PROTEST SCHEDULE**

**9.1** A boat intending to protest shall inform the other boat and shall display a red Protest flag at the first reasonable opportunity. Try to resolve protests on the water with the 720 rule.

**9.2** LGYC Gentleman Policy: Strict adherence to "no-collision" rules

**9.3** If the protest is not resolved on the water, the boat that is protesting must display the Protest flag when crossing the finish line and must notify the Race Committee 30 minutes after the committee boat returns to the dock. Arbitration may be heard and is encouraged immediately following the conclusion of races that evening, if agreeable to all parties involved. Any protest filed following races of the Spring or Summer Series, will be heard within one (1) week following the date of the incident at the Protest Hearing. The Protest Committee will consist of no more than 3 people appointed by the Race Chairman. This affects only the protest hearing schedule. It does not affect the protest requirements that must be met in accordance to the RRS at the time of the incident.

## 10 TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded for the Spring and Summer Series and the Manifest Race at the yearend Party following the Manifest Race.

## 11 VENUE

All races shall be held on Lake Granby, Granby, CO. See Addendum B for a map of Lake Granby and the locations of the marks.

## 12 RACE COMMITTEE

Competitors who serve as Race Committee in leu of their boat competing on their normal day of racing will receive a score for the races that they officiated as described in **13.3 SCORING RC**.

## 13 SCORING

**13.1** Scoring shall follow Rule 90.3(a) and Appendix A4 the Low Point Scoring System with the modifications stated in this Notice of Series and the Series SI's.

**13.2** Appendix A 4.1 is modified so that First Place is awarded 0.75 points. **Rule 90.3(b) is not modified.** A **DSQ** is not eligible to be thrown out and will be listed as **DNE**.

**13.3** Appendix A 4.2 is modified as follows:

**DNF, RET**(Retired) = scored as number of **finishers** plus 1.

**DNS, OCS** = scored as number of **starters** + 2.

**DNE** = number of boats entered in the **series** + 1, but not eligible to be thrown out,

**RC** = scored as the average of all their series finish scores, after throw outs.

Note: based on **3.1 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**, "**All Races sailed prior to complete payment of their 2020 membership dues will be scored DNS.**"

**13.4** **RCP** is a score designation if redress is filed by a competitor and the hearing results are that the RC did not adhere to the SI's.

## 14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The Race Committee reserves the right to make announcements on the water via VHF radio on channel 68 in addition to announcements made under Code L. These may include OCS calls and advanced warning of upcoming starting sequences and schedules. Failure to hear the radio signals is not subject to redress.

## 15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY



Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. (See **RRS Rule 4 Decision to Race**.) Lake Granby Yacht Club, as the organizing authority, will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the series.

Addendum A

**Starting Sequence and Signals**

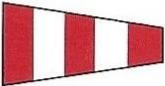
Minutes before starting Signal	Visual Signal	Sound Signal	Means
6	None	Three	Alert for Racers
5	RC Flag 	One	Warning signal
4	Preparatory Flag 	One	Preparatory signal
1	Preparatory Flag Removed	One Long	One minute
0	RC Flag Removed	One	Starting Signal



**Individual Recall** (Flag X, 1 sound) One or more boats were over the starting line early and must go back to restart.



**General Recall** (First Substitute, 2 sounds) The RC can't identify all boats over the line early, so the fleet is recalled for a new start.

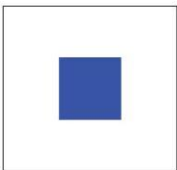


**Postponement** (Answering Pennant, 2 sounds) Races not started are postponed until later in the day or the next day.



**Abandonment** (Flag N, 3 sounds) The race is abandoned.

Shorten Course



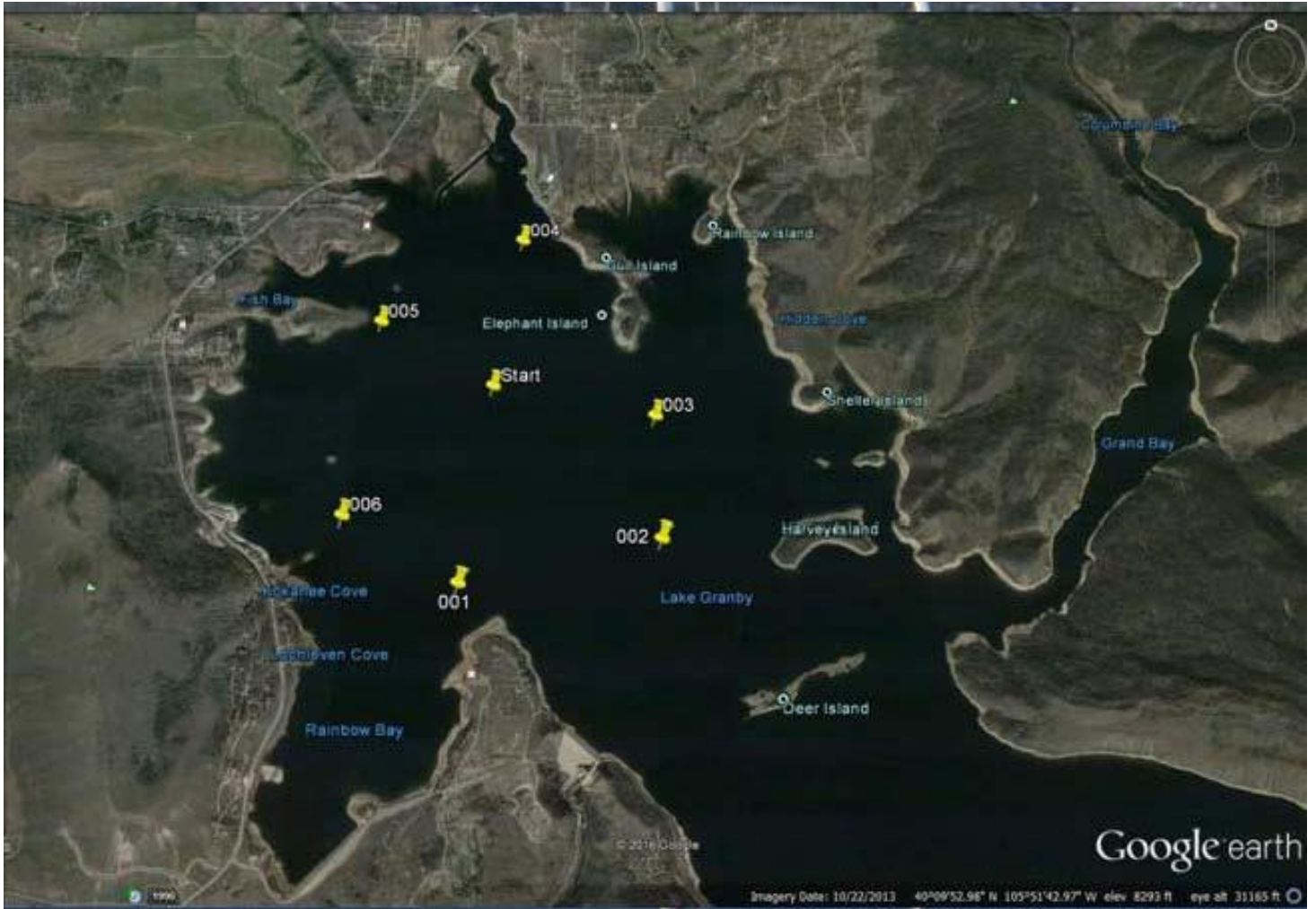
**S** The course has been shortened. Rule 32.2 is in effect.
